We are delighted to be able to welcome spectators to Walsh Park for Sunday's Co. Senior Hurling Final between Ballygunner v Roanmore. Please take note of the following Match Day Information for everyone travelling to game.

Ticket Sales

All tickets are widely available online. Only those with a valid ticket will be allowed enter.

One Ticket = One Entry.

Traffic Restrictions before and during match.

A cordon will be put in place around Walsh Park. Cordon in place from 9am to 5pm. The cordon will consist of the following points.

- At Keane's Road/Griffith Place Junction (Road Closed to all Traffic)
- Vincent White Road at Ashe Road Roundabout will be closed off up to Walsh Park Arbour Road Junction. (Road closed to Traffic)
- Slievekeale Road/Bernard Place Junction to Keane's Road Junction (Back of Stand) (Road closed to Traffic)
- Tycor Road to Roundabout at Keane's Road (Road closed to Traffic)

Match Day Parking

Walsh Park is located in a residential area and illegal parking will not be tolerated. Anyone who is found to be obstructing entrances or emergency routes will have their vehicle removed by the Gardai. The Gardai will be present and monitoring parking in the area on the day. There are a number of **FREE** Official Match Parking Areas which include:

- Presentation Secondary School – Enter via Cannon Street - FREE Parking
- Mount Sion GAA Social Centre – Free Parking and Outdoor Bar on site – EIR Code X91 RK51 – Less than 1km from pitch
- Rear of Waterford Shopping Centre – X91 X661 – 2km
- Waterford Crystal Car Park – EIR Code X91 VY04 - Pay Parking
- City Centre Car-Parks - 3kms – Free and Pay Parking

Covid Regulations

Spectators should be aware that in attending GAA, Camogie and LGFA games not all the risks posed from Covid-19 can be eliminated but that essential control measures have been put in place to reduce risks for spectators.

Spectators must not attend games if they display any symptoms of Covid-19 and instead should phone their GP and follow public health advice.

Individuals that are considered high risk or are in close contact with others who are considered high risk should not attend games ([click here](#))

We highly recommend the use of face coverings is required for all patrons over the age of 13 (including those who have been vaccinated)

Spectators must not enter the field of play at any time, whether pre-match, at half-time and other intervals or after the final whistle or at end-of-match presentations

Spectators should be advised to keep their own record of contacts at a match for potential tracing purposes.

Social Distancing

It is imperative that all spectators (including those who have been vaccinated) adhere to social distancing guidelines when travelling to games, arriving at the ground, in the seated areas, on the terraces, using toilets and facilities, when leaving the ground and travelling home.

More Information

Entry for patrons to the Stadium will be from the stiles at the roundabout or Upper Keane's Road.

Media Entrance is located at the middle of the Stand, opposite the Waterford Health Park. Must present valid ID and be accredited in advance of the game.

Gates will open at 12:30pm. The stand is unreserved and seats are on a first come first served basis. Entry via Stand also leads to the Terraces.

Patrons must ensure they continue to follow all Government Covid Guidelines to ensure everyone's safety.
